LINE WEIGHT: Fish must be caught in accordance with Club tournament & IGFA rules

FISHING AREA: Chart 54 (modified). Random access permitted.

TEAMS: Anglers may fish this tournament as individuals including fishing from PWCs and kayaks as long as they have VHF communications with Tauranga Coastguard CH01

BRIEFING: 6.30pm Friday, 10th November 2023

NOTE: Briefing is compulsory and team captains or a nominated team member who is fishing the tournament must register at the office on briefing night, no later than 6.00pm and is to attend and remain until the conclusion of briefing unless prior approval to not attend has been given by the Tournament Convenor. All Anglers MUST collect "Angler Number Cards" from TSFC prior to fishing.

START FISHING: After briefing on Friday the 10th November 2023

Final fish length entry in time shall be the end of the contest. All fish photos on approved NZ Fishing Competition tape, & catch cards must be submitted to fishing@taurangacoastguard.co.nz no later than 3:00pm 11th November (no exceptions).

FAILURE TO ADHERE TO TOURNAMENT RULES MAY RESULT IN PENALTIES BEING IMPOSED.
